



The Community and Discipleship Pastor at The River represents our commitment to the personal and spiritual growth of our community by coordinating the volunteer work of the church. In addition, this person will oversee the strategic development and execution of relational discipleship strategies, educational opportunities and activation of ministry and connection in the community beyond the walls of The River.

THE COMMUNITY AND DISCIPLESHIP PASTOR AT THE RIVER IS SOMEONE WHO:

- Has an evident and active relationship with Jesus.
- Determines, implements and directs the strategy for moving invested community members of The River into appropriate areas of service within the church, and meaningful areas of service and impact outside of the church.
- Develops and oversees new and ongoing education initiatives and community partnerships at The River, including the vetting and oversight of organizations and individuals tasked with content delivery and the evaluation of effectiveness.

IN ADDITION, THE COMMUNITY AND DISCIPLESHIP PASTOR WILL:

- Be responsible for piloting a method of effective, relationship-based discipleship at The River.
- Develop an educational component designed to help The River grow in knowledge and understanding of the work of the Holy Spirit.
- Develop effective ways to engage The River in providing meaningful impact in the community outside of the church with an emphasis on the marginalized populations The River is called to serve.
- Oversee and equip the deacons in their individual areas of service and lead the Deacon board in monthly meetings.
- Oversee The River's Celebrate Recovery Program as well as other ongoing ministries at The River.
- Participate as a senior staff member in the ongoing pursuit of a cohesive and positive staff team.
- Contribute as a senior staff member to oversight of The River's Mercy ministry.
- Maintain, as a senior staff member, mentoring relationships with River attenders, as is reasonable and appropriate.
- Take an active role in the planning and execution of weekly services and special events at The River.
